Our ambition for Net Zero

At Ashtons Legal, we are committed to supporting the government goal of Net Zero by 2050, albeit we openly acknowledge the realistic achievement of this goal is reliant on many factors outside of our immediate control, the most important being advances in technology for carbon capture or sequestration.

To help support that goal, we have started our journey by engaging with Auditel to help accurately measure our carbon footprint and to set science based carbon reduction targets. By then embedding the annual process of measure, reduce, verify and report into our organisation, we will drive continuous improvement in our GHG emissions control and reduction.

We recognise that accurate and honest measurement of our baseline carbon emissions and setting of reduction targets using a well-known and respected carbon auditor are the first essential steps in our journey to Net Zero. We believe this provides a transparent, uniform and rigorous approach to emission management, meaning all our stakeholders can trust in the results it reports.





Making low Carbon a way of life

We are always conscious of the environmental impact of our business activities and ensure that we review, monitor and improve the firm's environmental performance over time. Wherever possible we minimise this impact through responsible procurement, consumption and disposal. We minimise our environmental impact through:

- Staff travel we minimise travel and travel-based carbon emissions through video and telephone conferencing wherever possible.
- Energy consumption all our offices are on renewable energy tariffs and we have installed energy efficient equipment, such as LED lighting, to reduce our energy consumption.
- Paper We recommend to staff that they store and edit documents electronically to reduce printing.
- Information Promote responsibility for the environment within the organisation and communicate and implement this policy at all levels within the workforce.
- Compliance we will comply with all relevant environmental legislation/regulation.
